**Keep Cass County Beautiful will pay half of the recycling fee of one item per household. If you're a KCCB member, one item will be FREE! NO LARGE APPLIANCES ACCEPTED AT THIS EVENT DUE TO SPACE**

***The following items will have an Environmental Fee:***

- Bulk alkaline batteries: \$1.00 per pound;
- All styles of Televisions (including flat screens) & CRT (Cathode Ray Tube) Monitors:
  - \$20 up to 20", \$30 up to 30",
  - \$40 up to 40" and \$50 up to 50", and so forth.

***Fee is calculated by screen size & measured diagonally.***

***The following items will be collected at no charge:***

- Computers: Desktops, Laptops and Tablets;
- Flat Screen Computer Monitors; Key Boards & Mice;
- Network Equipment, Servers, Modems;
- Small Copiers, Printers, Fax Machines;
- (No Large Floor Model Copiers/Printers accepted)**
- Cameras, Cell Phones, Communication Devices;
- Electronic Toys, Projectors, Sound Equipment;
- Video Equipment, Stereos, DVD Players, Games;
- Rechargeable Batteries, Small Appliances;
- Home & Car Audio Equipment, Wire, Cables;
- Microwaves, Vacuums
