SENCA Job Skills

- Participants receive required text book, clothing, etc.
- Participants are required to attend 90 days of case management to help encourage self sufficiency

SENCA SMART Financial Literacy

SENCA SMART (Strategic Money and Resource Techniques) Financial Literacy provides participating 8th and 12th grade students a comprehensive financial education program focusing on money management, budgeting, credit, education and saving.

- The five session curriculum utilizes the Hands on Banking financial literacy program that meets the Nebraska State Standards of Education.
- Students participate in a 2 hour Poverty Simulation that allows participants to experience real life poverty situations and discover solutions to help them achieve economic stability.
- The program is measured by pre and post test outcomes. On average participating students increase their financial literacy knowledge and skill by 30%.

Food Pantry Pick-up Tuesdays and Thursdays

During the pandemic, SENCA will provide households in need with a food pantry once a month. **Pantries need to be requested by phone and will be available for pick-up on either Tuesdays or Thursdays at the Plattsmouth Outreach Office.** Adjustments for food distribution is made on a case-by-case basis.

Services: SENCA encourages Cass County residents experiencing food insecurity or other hardships, especially during these challenging times, to contact the local SENCA office. Our staff works one-on-one with economically challenged households to help provide solutions to identified need.

Need: As additional resources become available program guidelines could change in an effort to assist more households in need. If for some reason SENCA is unable to offer assistance, households will be provided a list of additional area resources.
